Easter Flowers for the Sanctuary



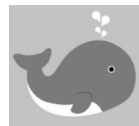

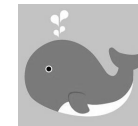

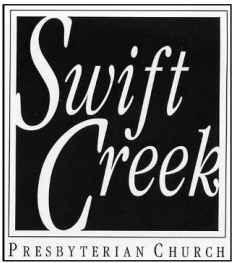
