Chris Gaertner, husband of Leah Haney Gaertner and one of our Mission partners, will be joining us later in the meeting to talk about the great work they are doing with Cru in China.

We are fortunate to have Dr Richard Haney with us here today. He is married to Pam and they have three married daughters: Leah, Charlotte and Emily. They have been blessed with nine grandchildren. Richard served Swift Creek from its beginning in 1990 until 2003. He then went on to study in Oxford and earn a PhD in mission theology in 2014. After serving five churches as an interim pastor from 2003-2013, Richard became Executive Director of Frontier Fellowship in 2014. Frontier Fellowship mobilizes American churches and individuals to get involved in frontier mission. Frontier mission includes church planting, Bible translation, teaching, training, etc. among the world's unreached peoples. Almost 2.5 billion people in the world are "unreached" and currently have no chance of hearing the Good News of Jesus Christ. Frontier Fellowship has partners and projects in India, Bangladesh, Pakistan, Afghanistan, Central Asia, the Middle East, Ethiopia, Sudan, Niger and Egypt.
