*A Declaration of Faith The Nicene Creed

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven

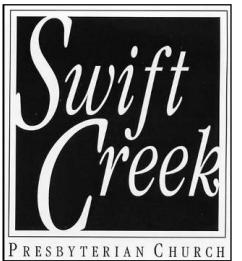
